- ✓ During the month of April we will be reviewing and practicing our safety procedures as a school. These procedures include Fire Drills, Hold and Secure Procedures, Lock Down Procedures,

Severe Weather Procedures, and Shelter In Place Procedures.

- ✓ A reminder to all parents that are picking up children at the end of the day to meet your child under the large cross and St. James School sign. Many parents are using our bus loading zone as a form of “Kiss and Ride”. The bus loading zone is not a ‘Kiss and Ride” and the increased number of parents pulling in as our students are being dismissed is causing very serious safety concerns for our students. Please help us ensure the safety of all our students by following these steps:
 1. Only park in official parking spots perpendicular to the cemetery or in the other church parking lot to the south of the church. Please do not block the entrance or exit of our bus loading area. Please do not double park while waiting for others to leave their parking spots.
 2. Walk to the area under the large cross and St. James School sign and meet your child there.
 3. Walk back to your parked vehicle.
